NOTICE OF CLARIFICATION
in
DUPONT/CORTEVA PENSION LITIGATION
Robert Cockerill et al. v. Corteva, Inc. et al., No. 2:21-cv-03966-MMB (E.D. Pennsylvania) (the “Litigation”)

You are receiving this Notice of Clarification because you are an Early Retirement class member or potential class member in the Litigation.

On or about December 18, 2025, you received a Notice of Final Judgment. Due to a subsequent order of the Court clarifying your rights, the deadline for you to make an election for Early Retirement benefits has been extended to 120-days from the date of this Notice of Clarification.

*Information may have been provided to you by the Plan Administrator or Corteva Connection that incorrectly limited the retroactive benefits you are entitled to elect as a result of this lawsuit. **If you already requested and received a retirement kit from Corteva Connection based on information inconsistent with this Notice of Clarification, you must contact Corteva Connection to make a new benefit election.***

*Early Retirement Class Members are entitled to elect a retroactive benefit **beginning on any date following the Spin-off (May 31, 2019)** after attaining age 50 while still working for DuPont de Nemours, Inc. or one of its wholly owned subsidiaries (“New DuPont”).*

In order to receive this retroactive benefit, Early Retirement Class Members will be required to terminate their employment with New DuPont no later than 120 days from the date of this Notice of Clarification.

If you are not currently employed by New DuPont, you do not need to terminate your employment.

Early Retirement Class Members may also select a date in the future to commence their Early Retirement benefits.
